## To all passenger and crew on board the MS FRAM

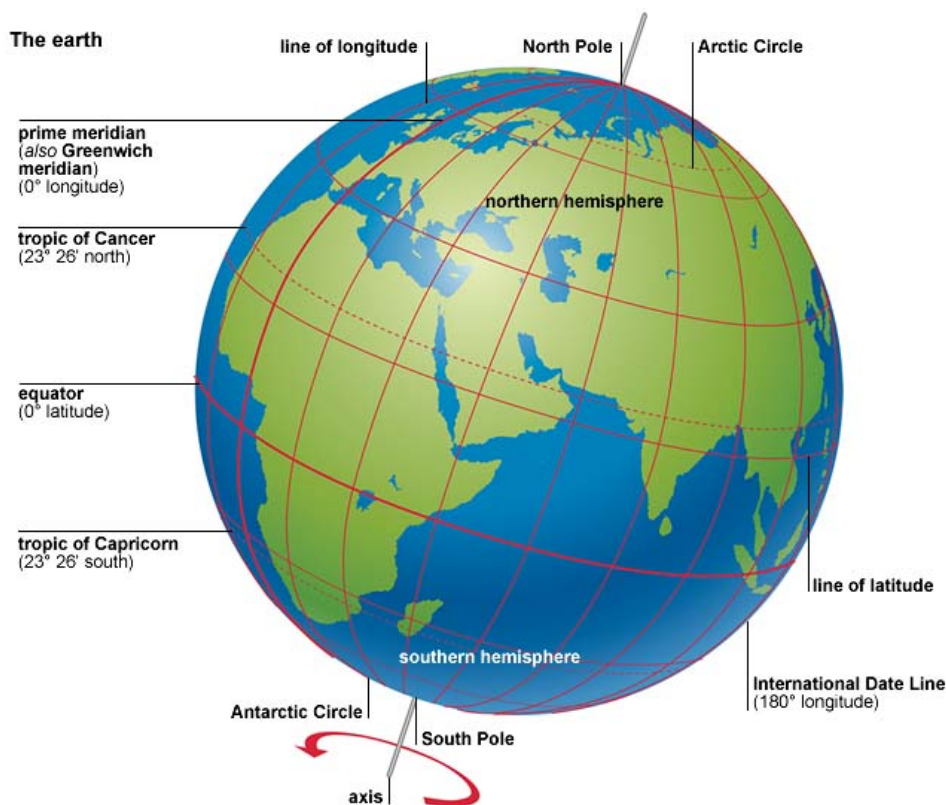

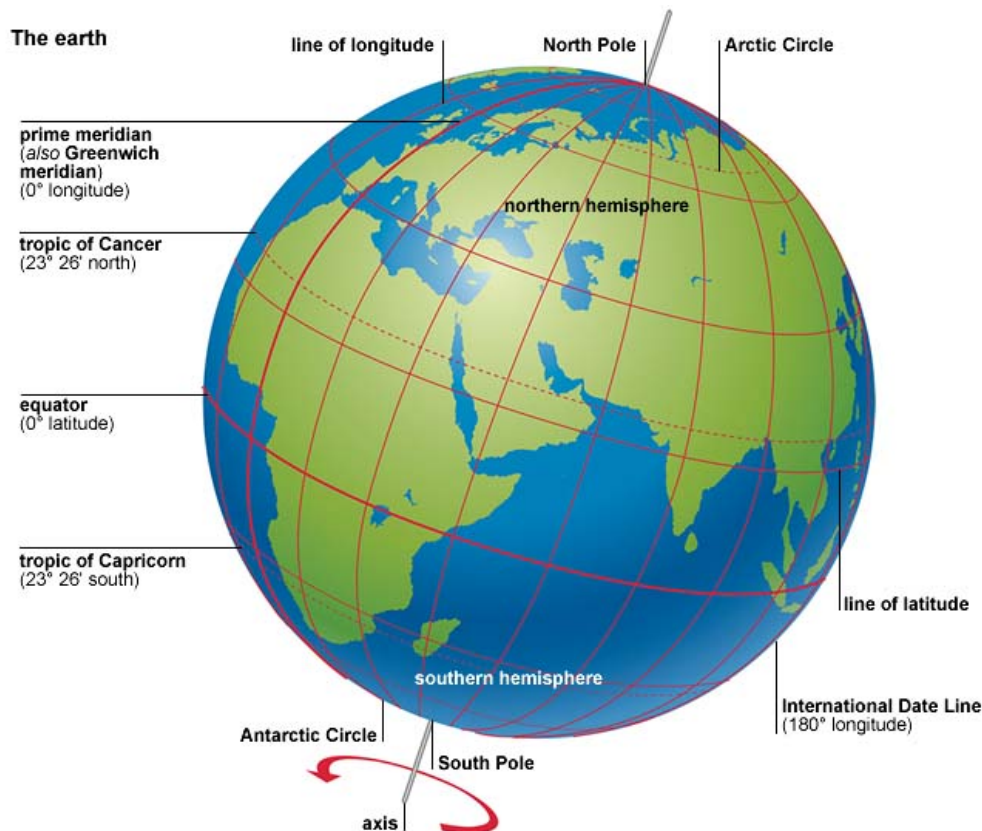
